The Michoud Operations event will be held in the Plimssoll Club of the World Trade Center located at the foot of Canal Street. ■

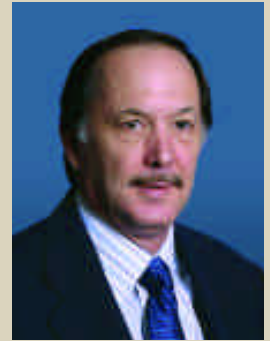
